Contributions are not deductible for income tax purposes. Contributions to GNARPAC are voluntary and are used for political purposes. The amount suggested is merely a guideline and you may contribute more or less than the suggested amount. You may refuse to contribute without reprisal and the National Association of REALTORS® or any of its state associations and local boards will not favor or disfavor any member because of the amount contributed. The GNARPAC Trustees will determine annually an amount which will be forwarded to the State PAC. The amount for the 2010 RPAC giving year is \$44,000.

GNARPAC will retain all contributions received about that amount for use in the Middle Tennessee region; exceptions will be made in the case of "Major Donors." Of the funds forwarded to the State PAC, 70% of each contribution is used by your State PAC to support state and local candidates. Until your State PAC reaches its RPAC goal, 30% is sent to National RPAC to support federal candidates and it charged against your limits under 2 U.S.C. 441a; after the State PAC reaches its RPAC goal it may elect to retain your entire contribution for use in supporting state and local candidates.
